Religious Ed (CCD) still needs 2 more (Gr. 5 & 8) teachers! Teachers need to be fingerprinted and pass a criminal background check. As well, VIRTUS Child Protection training is required by the Diocese of Trenton. VIRTUS Training sessions will be offered here on August 29th or October 11th (advance registration required). Please consider participating in this important ministry with our parish youth. Please contact Sr. Bernadette ASAP. We really need your help!

Registration for Religious Ed classes is taking place now. If your family is new to the parish or to the program, please stop in or call the Office for forms. **If you are registering a child for Kindergarten or Gr. 1, please bring your child's Baptismal Certificate.** Families currently enrolled already received re-registration forms and information through the mail.

Sacraments Preparation for **First Eucharist** takes place normally in Gr. 2. We do have a class for older students who have not received their sacraments. In order to enter the First Eucharist Class, the Gr. 1 curriculum, must be completed. **Confirmation** preparation takes place in Gr. 7 & 8. Religious Ed class for Gr. 7 must be completed before entering the Gr. 8 program.

VIRTUS for adults training is presented throughout the year at different locations. ANY adult volunteer or staff member working with children is **REQUIRED** to attend this one-time training session and also submit to fingerprinting & criminal background check.
